FOURTH CHAPTER was reserved for a half, lodged a strong five wide move to take the lead on the turn then drew off under good handling. KALEIGH ROSE steadied in traffic soon after the start, was unhurried along the backstretch, checked along the inside midway on the turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished willingly for the place. DONNA'S SANDEE moved up along the inside to contest the pace before going a half, steadied along the rail while lacking room on the turn then rallied belatedly. MILK RUN was outrun for five furlongs, angled four wide at the quarter pole and closed late from outside. ALYSSA GIVONNA settled just off the pace, lodged a bid between horses to threaten on the turn and weakened late. BATTLE OF BRITAIN was unhurried for a half, advanced between horses on the turn, angled six wide and lacked a strong closing bid. MAGNIFICENT TRUTH checked at the start, raced between horses in traffic on the far turn, checked a bit in upper stretch and tired. SATIN SILVER was never close after being pinched back at the start. MAGNIFICENT LOOKER chased between horses and tired on the turn. ONION QUEEN set the pace for five furlongs and steadied while tiring on the turn.
