REMITTANCE raced along the outside while unhurried, crept towards the runaway leader during the run around the second bend, while still keeping something in reserve, came three wide into the lane, was given his cue after being straightened away, made up a good chunk of real estate to reach the pacesetter's hind quarters with a furlong remaining, took over at the sixteenth pole and edged away under a hand ride. THE PLOT THICKENS stole away to a sizeable advantage soon after leaving the starting gate, under his own power, continued to show the way two to three wide on an open lead, came under assault departing the eighth pole, offered some resistance before yielding with a sixteenth to go, but continued on with good courage to well clear of the others for the place. GRAND PIANO MAN came home willingly for the show. PAVLOV'S DOG saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. KICK UP YOUR HEELS was no factor. INTERFERENCE never threatened. ROYAL LORD took the inside route and failed to reach a contending position. END OF THE GULCH was through after going three-quarters. GIOPI (IRE) prominently placed for six furlongs, gave way.
