Footnotes

BOLD WARRIOR broke alertly, commenced to duel with AUGUST OSAGE almost from the get-go, raced as a team with that opponent throughout the opening half, had already grabbed a slim lead when finally let out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, then drew clear under a vigorous hand ride. AUGUST OSAGE got engaged in a spirited tussle with the top one, went at practically head to head until the quarter pole, was shaken off a short distance into the stretch run, despite having been asked for a response, continued on with good courage to garner place honors. PRAISE THE BIRD rode the rail, angled out several paths midstretch, finished well to take the show. SAME OLD WISH was hustled into a forward position, pursued the duelers during the run around the bend, was set down to a drive coming to the five-sixteenths pole and got out finished. EXCISE THE DEMONS was driven four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PERCUSSION raced within striking distance while well off the inside, was struck repeatedly on the right shoulder from the half mile pole to the quarter pole, bore out turning for home and failed to menace thereafter.
