WOODLANDER raced with the pace while three wide, responded when roused and drew clear late, driving. LONDON was bumped after the start, raced with the pace from the outside and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. FRIAR was bumped after the start, raced close up along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. DYNAMIC CONTOUR was bumped after the start, was outrun early, raced inside and was going well late. HIGH OCTANE was bumped after the start, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. DOUBLE TAP ENTRY chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. MR. KRUSH raced three wide and tired. GALLANT NOTION was bumped after the start, was steadied, raced inside and tired.
