Footnotes

SAYITISH'TSO JOE rated along the outside off the speed duel, gradually worked his way forward midway on the turn while still not being asked for his best, surged past the leader under hand urging approaching midstretch, quickly extended his advantage, had his rider glance back for any impending challengers and finding none on the horizon, was taken in hand confidently in the late stages. JUSTIN P outrun early, responded once in the lane, split rivals past the furlong marker and closed well. PAY THE JUDGE saved ground until angling to the outside in upper stretch and came home willingly. SLICK WHEELIE angled of the rail on the turn, lacked a rally. CARR RIDE away alertly, set the pace under pressure for a half and gave way. ROCK KEY raced wide until late turn, angled over to the inside and tired. ALABAMA'S FLYING was never prominent. TRIBOLET went head to head from the outside in a spirited duel for the lead for a half and folded. SENOR MONEY BUNDLE was never a threat.
