Footnotes

HANGINGBYATHREAD was well placed along the inside, gained between horses while angling three wide on the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and drew off under left hand encouragement. D' WILDCARD was outrun for a half, waited behind a wall of horses leaving the turn, swung four wide while splitting rivals at the top of the stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. RIPTIDE (ARG) was rated just off the pace while saving ground, waited along the rail leaving the turn, swung three wide and finished willingly. DANCING TIN MAN was outrun to the turn, drifted six wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. MOON ALA MODE stumbled at the start, rushed up from outside to contest the pace on the backstretch, pressed the lead to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. HEDGEFUND INVESTOR set the pace along the rail for seven furlongs and gave way. TYPHOON TYCOON raced up close from outside early, dropped back on the far turn and steadily tired thereafter.
