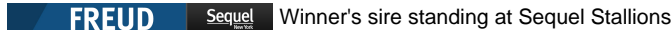

KARAKORUM ELEKTRA raced just off the pace between horses, steadied in traffic then altered course to the outside in midstretch and closed strongly to get up in the final strides. BATON ROUGE pressed three wide for a half, made a run to challenge in midstretch, surged to the front in deep stretch and was nipped by the winner at the wire. NOTHING IMPOSSIBLE raced in close contention along the fence the entire way and finished willingly to gain a share. ANOTHER SUCCESS raced in the middle of the pack along the inside, swung five wide at the quarter pole and closed late from outside. PURELY BY CHANCE angled in while setting the pace into midstretch and weakened late. PAVORATTI'S SOUL broke slowly, saved ground while well back, angled three wide and lacked a strong closing bid. LYKE A HURRICANE was under a firm hold inside, steadied at the half mile pole, swung four wide while gaining on the turn and flattened out late. CALL TIGER raced within striking distance from outside, swung wide on the turn and lacked a late response. SYSTEM RESTORE steadied in traffic on the far turn and was never close thereafter. LOHAD checked at the start and was never close thereafter.
