Footnotes

CHAYSEN' ALEX was perched three wide off the pacesetter during the run down the backstretch, ranged up when ready around the bend, still keeping something in reserve, effortlessly struck the front nearing the top of the stretch, increased the advantage after being roused, drew off leaving the eighth pole, had the rider take a couple of quick peeks back in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and seeing no imminent danger in sight, completed the race under his own power. VINDICAT contested the pace along the outside, gained a brief lead entering the turn, proved no match for the winner once confronted, but continued on well enough to be well clear of the others for the place. SIR JOHN broke slowly, spotting the competition several lengths at the break, rushed up into contention down the backstretch under his own volition, was steadied briefly nearing the turn in an attempt to conserve energy, raced four wide around the turn, made steady progress until the quarter pole, then flattened out. WE GET IT raced off the inside, was guided over to the rail in upper stretch, lacked a solid kick after being called upon. POTOMAC MOON displayed brief foot. LOVE OF LIFE vied inside for a half and faded. FLO'S HONOR was never involved.
