SAND AND SONG reserved off the inside, began to pick up the pace after going a half while not being asked for her best, swung wide into the lane, commenced her rally five wide after being put to encouragement, steadily advanced towards the front runner, took over in deep stretch and edged clear, driving. DEAR MARYLOU raced towards the inside, was put to a strong left handed pressure while angling outward midstretch, then continued on willingly to be along for the place. WINE BAR established command soon after the start, cruised along on the front, uncontested, faced a challenger for the initial time leaving the furlong grounds, succumbed with a sixteenth to go and steadily weakened thereafter. TOMORROWS ROSES chased the pacesetter from the outside and tired. A GIRL NAMED MARIA bumped at the start, displayed a mild rally to improve her position during the stretch run. GREEN ARROWS fell to face at the start, but was able to recover from that ordeal. rode the rail, worked her way into contention during the run around the bend, checked sharply when DEAR MARYLOU crossed over at the eighth pole, with sufficient daylight separating them, then was allowed to complete the race under wraps. WISE CHOICE failed to contend. GATA PERRA within range for a half, was steadied after being bothered in the vicinity of the furlong marker. POSEY PARK saved ground to no avail. QUITTERS NEVER WIN was bumped at the start, raced along the outside and was through after going a half. There was a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch drive before the result was declared official.
