WARRANT OFC. COOK sat within range from the two path for nearly three-quarters, spun three wide into upper stretch and was asked for a response, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, picked up ground more readily thereafter, took over in deep stretch and edged clear. RAPHAEL ALEXANDRO established control soon after the start and was taken over to the inside as quickly as possible, showed the way facing only mild resistance for a half, felt some heat soon afterwards, had SILVER BIRCH drew alongside midway on the turn, was put to encouragement to keep pace with that one during the later stages of the turn around the bend, dug in stubbornly until the end, but had to settle for show honors. SILVER BIRCH raced along the outside, patiently stalked the leader down the backstretch, crept up to that foe upon entering the turn and cranked up the pressure, was roused turning for home, and got out finished. ELDER SKATESMAN saved ground until the quarter pole and tired. SENOR ENRICO raced three wide and folded.
