BOISTEROUS sat reserved three wide just off the pacesetter, bid when ready nearing the quarter pole, grabbed command in the next stride leaving the eighth pole, and edged away, driving. GRASSY under a snug hold, raced along the outside, unhurried, swung five wide for the stretch run and displayed a good kick en route for the place. KINDERGARDEN KID urged four wide into the stretch, was along for the show. GRAND RAPPORT rated prompting the pacesetter from the outside, came up empty for the stretch run. BOLD HAWK rode the rail until the quarter pole, was commencing to rally one path off the inside, when his lane was closed down by the pair of opponents just up ahead, hesitated for a couple of jumps, regained the clearance, shot through between rivals, loomed momentarily with an eighth to go but quickly flattened out. WISHFUL TOMCAT chewed vigorously on the bit, establishing command during the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, showed the way from the inside until the quarter pole and succumbed readily when challenged.
