Footnotes

MAXIMOVA was off slowly, was trailing the next to last opponent in the early stages by almost four lengths at the halfway point on the elbow chute, was down along the rail at the head of the stretch, pulling rankly at the bit, had one rival abandon the inside route and moved up slightly to improve position, lost that ground getting mildly shuffled back on the far turn, approached the quarter pole, forced to bide time and under a good hold from the pilot, gained room to advance when GLORIOUS CHANT got angled out after spinning into the lane, was given her cue and responded positively, angled out sharply in the vicinity of the eighth pole, carrying out and bumping HOT TEMPO in the process, kicked into gear after finishing this course of action, drew even with a sixteenth to go, grabbed away the advantage soon afterwards and drew clear, crossing the wire being primarily hand urged. CORPORATE CULTURE looped several rivals shortly after the start to take up the role of primary pursuer, proved ratable from the two path while prompting the pacesetter, increased the pressure just as the front runners were turning for home, was a couple of jumps into upper stretch before getting called upon for her best, left the furlong marker as the new leader, got collared by the top one about a sixteenth later, held on well for the place. HOT TEMPO patiently stalked from off the inside during the opening stages, travelled three wide on the far turn, neared the quarter pole and was put to encouragement, was bothered and bumped by the winner in midstretch, dug in reasonably well thereafter en route for the show. ALYDORABLE was swung off the rail departing the elbow chute and remained off the inside thereafter, was let out at the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch three wide under a full drive, mustered up a mild response to take the last major check. SIMILU (GB) launched her way into contention with a four wide run into the teeth of the fastest split of event, flattened out. GLORIOUS CHANT saved ground to upper stretch, got taken out and came up empty. LEMON SONG rated along the inside until the quarter pole, was set down shortly after setting the third fraction, remained a prominent factor to the furlong marker then gave way.
