### Footnotes

DECLAN'S WARRIOR unhurried during the opening half, picked up interest during the late stages of the run around the bend, swung four wide into upper lane, was a few strides into the stretch run when tipped out an additional lane, closed in with good energy on the front runners, getting up in the final stages to prove best. TENANGO briefly in the pocket nearing the end of the backstretch was back to being two wide by the top of the turn, was swung four wide into the stretch, outkicked a pair to take over with an eighth to go, continued on in a willing manner despite getting reeled in by the winner late. BATTIER got grabbed hold after taking an initial step outward at the break, was the lone member of the field to spend time down along the fence, was under urging launching a clear rail rally cutting the corner into the lane, flattened out. DUKE OF THE CITY prompted the leader three wide for much of the way down the backstretch and around the turn, weakened leaving the eighth pole. HAPPY MY WAY gained command soon after the start, cut the pace under a firm to snug hold by the pilot, even after DUKE OF THE CITY increased his presence at the crown of the turn, was a couple of jumps into upper stretch and under heavy assault from both sides before getting released from the previously-described grip, failed to fire and backed away.
