JADE RUN swerved inward sharply at the start, in the direction of a gap where the end of the clubhouse turn meets the end of the chute, was given some brisk encouragement as motivation and responded willingly to it, rushing up along the rail to take over, cut the pace now being rated along, arrived at the end of the bend and was set down for the stretch, dug in well during the late stages to fend off the runner up. THNXTOMYUNCLE stalked the pacesetter, was guided over to the inside route coming to the five-sixteenths marker, stayed along it only momentarily, got angled back to the outside and asked for run at the top of the lane, closed in readily on the winner but had to settle for the place. BERNARDO stumbled at the start, requiring the rider to take a good hold, departed the backstretch from between rivals and remained so for nearly the next quarter, was swung outward three wide into the stretch, got straightened away and rallied for the show. HERE HE FITZ coaxed from the two path chasing the winner, weakened in the final furlong. CAT MAN FU came four wide into upper stretch, lacked a solid offering. M SIX quickly tucked along the rail, was put to a drive at the top of the turn, made no headway a furlong down the road, paused under some restraint then was put back to a drive cutting the corner into the lane, still made no headway and tired. SONG OF ASPEN three wide and set down at the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
