Footnotes

BOZIQUE just off the inside in mid pack, advanced under urging along the rail from the three-eighths into contention at the quarter pole, angled sharply over heels to the two path as DAHTESTE cut the corner in front, dug in under a drive confronting that foe through the final eighth, wore down that rival to just get up and prevail in the last strides. DAHTESTE dueled under coaxing from the two path, shifted to the rail at the nine-sixteenths, began to shake away from her main pace rival nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch to seal off the inside from the oncoming challenge, dug in under a drive fighting head to head with the aforementioned rival through the final eighth and was caught in the final strides while well clear of the rest. MISSED A WILDCAT saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild bid to prove best of the rest. BLUE SIXTY FOUR three wide in pursuit just off the pace urged from the five-sixteenths, swung two to three wide into the stretch and offered no serious response. PURE AFLEET three wide towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole, raced four wide through the turn, continued three to four wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the lane. THUNDER PRINCESS four wide throughout towards the rear, got asked for run at the five-sixteenths, improved position while making no headway on the front. SO MUCH HEART dueled two to three wide with DAHTESTE to her inside urged from midway on the turn, swung three wide into the stretch shaken off and gave way. PUMPKIN LANE tracked inside within aim early on, shifted out midway on the turn to be two or

three wide commencing encouragement, angled four wide into the lane and weakened. SHALALA chased three to four wide in close range ridden along from three furlongs out, spun five wide into the stretch tiring and was eased in the final eighth to the wire.
