BEST OF LUCK, hustled along to keep up early, advanced outside on the turn, came five wide approaching the stretch, responded to steady pressure and close determinedly to be clear under the wire. TREASURE ISLAND pressed the pace from the outside, dug in when roused nearing the stretch, reached the front between calls inside the eighth pole and stayed gamely but could not resist the winner. LEMON DROP KID, close up inside early on, finished gamely despite being in tight quarters between rivals in the stretch. DAVID was sent directly to the front, set the pace along the inside and gave ground grudgingly in the stretch. UNBRIDLED JET bobbled leaving the gate, brushing with COMEONMOM, then chased the pace from the outside, came four wide for the drive and stayed on stubbornly outside. KARLY'S HARLEY was hustled along on the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn and lacked a solid finishing kick. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL raced with the pace while three wide and in hand then faded in the final furlong. THE GROOM IS RED was hustled along inside, raced on the rail and had no response when roused. COMEONMOM, brushed at the start and hustled along early, chased along the inside and tired badly in the stretch.
