ANXIETY was patiently handled while traveling in the two path approaching the turn, continued to bide his time under a good hold between rivals during the run around the bend, was stacked five wide at top of the stretch, settled suddenly into stride, gobbling up good ground to enter the fracas by midstretch, then prevailed over SAX IN THE CITY in a game performance. SAX IN THE CITY was taken back slightly, content to give up the early lead, was steadied along the inside while awaiting racing room approaching the top of the stretch, responded willingly when put to a drive, gained a short advantage at the furlong marker, then dug in stubbornly to the wire. SEEING CLEARLY was steadied early, raced wide, lacked a strong response during the drive home. L D'S GALAXY set a comfortable pace until the furlong grounds and failed to keep up when the host of challengers made their presence felt. PRIVACY steadied shortly after the start, continued wide while in midpack, stacked six wide headstretch but lacked a response. GABRIELA'S ROSE came up empty off a ground saving journey. HOLY TROUBLE stalked the pace under a good hold until upper stretch and tired. JANSHAWATT chased three wide and faltered.
