Footnotes

YIELD BOGEY was reserved early, raced in traffic between horses on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch then closed steadily to get up in the final strides. BIG TRAIN stalked three wide, lodged a three wide move entering the stretch, surged to the front inside the furlong marker then was caught by the winner in the final strides. THOU SWELL was outrun after a slow start, saved ground well back on the turn, angled wide entering the stretch and finished full of run but could not get up. AMERICAN CRUISER set or forced the pace for a half, opened a clear lead in midstretch then yielded grudgingly. INTI (URU) was outrun to the turn, steadied while blocked behind a wall of horses at the quarter pole and failed to threaten thereafter. LEO (GB) saved ground in hand, waited along the rail on the turn and tired in upper stretch. GRAND MINSTREL pressed early, opened a clear lead on the far turn the gave way. GIMMEAROUTINE lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out.
