FRENCH TRANSITION vied for the lead from the outside while under a good hold, shook free approaching the quarter pole, responded well when roused in upper stretch, reached the eighth pole still maintaining a clear advantage, then proved best under good handling. HARD IRON forwardly placed early, dropped back a bit as the pace quickened down the backstretch, sat chilly along the outside off the tepid speed fight up front, swung into action late on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, took aim with a furlong remaining, but wasn't good enough. CHARING CROSS fought inside for the lead and tired after three-quarters. COMMISSIONER CHRIS put to a prolonged drive, was outrun. UNDOCUMENTED offered little.
