LIGHTS OUT LISA pursued the pacesetter three wide, kept up with that rival during the opening half while not being asked for her best, took off in earnest after being roused heading into the stretch, failed to gain significantly during the run through the furlong grounds, readily made up the necessary ground when the pacesetter began to shorten stride at the eighth pole, took charge and drew clear under a drive. NO RHYME OR REASON raced three wide around the turn, displayed a good late kick down the outside of the course to garner place honors. FLYING SAPPHO was taken in hand soon after the start, raced within striking distance, bobbled during the run down the backstretch, maintained a good striking position under light coaxing leaving the half mile pole, angled outward before commencing her rally in upper stretch, bobbled once again, was set down to a hard drive at the three-sixteenths pole, got outfinished. JUSTINLINE saved ground until the quarter pole. TREAT HER RIGHT set the pace from the two path, gave way leaving the eighth pole. PALS FIRST LADY was no factor. NORTHERN WARRIOR took the inside route and was never in the hunt. DESTINY ROAD was through after going a half.
