Footnotes

ISCAR was coaxed along while tracking the front runners from the rail, got set down to a hard drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was angled outward for the stretch run and drafted behind the runner up for a couple of jumps before maneuvered outward slightly more to split rivals in upper stretch, reached the eighth pole in a practical dead heat with CHARLESTONIAN, kicked clear, kept to the task at hand. CHARLESTONIAN established control before leaving the chute, took up residence from a slight distance from off the rail, set the opening splits, rating kindly and facing only token resistance, came under intensified pressure late on the turn and was soon let out in response, yielded to the top one in midstretch, but continued on well to secure second. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH outrun for six furlongs, went on to improve position in the stretch. PAWLEYS PORCH was lightly urged stalking the pacesetter three wide, backed away when unable to keep pace during the stretch run. CALL FIRST accompanied the leader from the outside for three-quarters, folded. SUMMER SHARE off the inside, failed to reach a contending position.
