LITTLE DALE moved together with THUNDER HARBOR to overhaul the early leader, vied for command from the outside until the quarter pole, got set down entering the stretch, matching the tactics already being employed by each pilot of the remaining foursome, shook free during run through the furlong grounds and held sway. ROCK STAR CHARLIE broke on top, was soon joined by another pair and dropped back into the role of stalker before reaching the half mile pole, was let out a notch to stay within range of the front runners, entered the stretch under much stronger handling and rallied to take the place. DEHERE OF THE CAT behaved skittishly during the loading procedure, requiring a little extra time and effort from the gate crew being successfully put into his stall, appeared to come out of the starting gate with no mishap, tucked along the rail coming to the half mile pole, was put to light encouragement, yet to failed to pick up interest noticeably, got roused more energetically while angling outward for the stretch drive, came up empty. THUNDER HARBOR argued for control from the inside for about a half then faltered. WISHINGONASTAR the widest of all on the turn and at the head of the stretch, trailed throughout.
