BELLE EPOQUE shook free of the others in the initial stages to gain control, sat entrenched in the two path, cutting the pace being rated along on a loosely-contested lead, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, left that station and was put to some encouragement, held her biggest advantage with a furlong remaining and stayed in the clear, driving. FU PEGGI SUE turned for home three wide and already having been put to encouragement, closed in willingly while earning the place award. SARAH'S WILD GIRL was bumped after the start, attended the pace three wide and gave way after entering the stretch. GALAXY GAL put to a prolonged drive, angled off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, eventually settled into the four pole a furlong later, proved no match. WILDCAT'S ELEMENT coaxed along while tracking the front runners sitting a loose pocket, faltered. CLASSICAL JET shied away from another and wound up making some contact with SARAH'S WILD GIRL a short distance out of the starting gate, left the three-eighths pole three wide, folded. PATRIOT'S JEWEL was never involved. MCGILLYCUDDY'S GAL reluctant to approach the starting gate, was choppy-gaited proceeding down the backstretch, trailed throughout, then was pulled up less than a furlong past the finish line.
