JUSTONEATHEGUYS three wide proceeding down the elbow chute, continued as the widest of the field down the backstretch as well, advanced steadily towards the leader upon entering the full turn, cleared the last remaining obstacle, that being MIDNIGHTINPOSITANO, and after tucking into the two path took on the pacesetter, poked a head down in front as the battle spilled over into the stretch, forged to a slightly bigger advantage after a spirited tussle through the furlong grounds, dug in well in the late stages to fend off the runner up. SAPHIRE BLUE sat reserved from of the inside for nearly three-quarters, was forced to remain on hold caught in some traffic behind rivals for several strides coming to the quarter pole, got asked for a response entering the stretch, ducked inward to go by the now-weakening primary pursuer in upper stretch, gained ground readily while continuing along the inside route for a furlong, altered course back to the outside with about a sixteenth to go, showed good belated foot en route for the place. ACROSTIC away with no apparent mishap, shook free in the very earliest stages and was guided over to the rail, showed the way, being rated along, had the winner announce her presence in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, fell back by the narrowest of margins as the pair spun into the lane, fought hard but couldn't regain the front, weakened into the show slot the last eighth. JUDY G placed into the three path midway on the turn, lacked the needed response. SHORTBREAD SCOTTY put to some coaxing tracking the front runners from the inside during the opening stages, vacated the premises during the later stages of the run around the bend, made no headway after turning for home. TIZALLHEART unseated the pilot and ran off for a short distance, was caught and brought back to gate, proceeding to duck in sharply at the start, and got steadied, tucked along the rail and rode it until upper stretch, made no impact. MIDNIGHTINPOSITANO accompanied the pacesetter from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
