SILVER SCREAMER four wide departing the backstretch, kept a watchful eye on the front runners, moved up to increase her presence late on the turn, reached the quarter pole now only three wide and challenged in earnest, took over before completing the next furlong, drifted out a couple of paths down the lane, got put strong right handed by the pilot as a countermeasure, dug in well to preserve the decision. LIMONAR (IRE) raced three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, left that station one path further to the outside, turned for home and got called upon, came home willingly but got staved off. J C'S QUEEN strung out four wide midpoint on the turn, displayed a mild stretch response en route for the show. BUTTON GIRL ducked outward a couple of steps leaving the gate, but was immediately put back on a truer course and assumed a forward post, disputed the pace three wide on the turn, remained a prominent factor until the furlong grounds before backing away. FINDING NEVERLAND (FR) left the customary abbreviated post parade early, was taken hold at the start after brushing with and getting carried out slightly by HIGH ABOVE, was allowed to settle into stride, advanced gradually on top portion of the turn, was let out a notch prior to being angled outward after completing the opening half, split rivals to continue her march forward, entered the stretch, failed to fire appreciably when asked for her best. PARAIBA three wide at the midway point on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. LINDZ WINZ was pulled off another leaving the starting gate, accelerated to grab the lead soon afterwards, vied from the two path for just over a half and tired. REVENUE raced towards the inside, was being hand urged by the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. VERSE CHOIR coaxed along giving chase from off the rail, folded. HIGH ALPINE made light contact with FINDING NEVERLAND at the start, saved ground to no avail afterwards.
