**Footnotes**

CAPTAIN GAUGHEN off the inside during the opening stages, gradually moved into contention, was sent over towards the inside and rode the rail for most of the way around the full turn, had his forward progress stalled when INFILTRATOR was guided over to the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was under a firm hold bidding time in the resulting traffic situation, found room to maneuver coming to the quarter pole and acted, fanning three wide into the lane, still unasked for speed, got straightened away and was put to brisk urging, picked up speed almost immediately, blowing by all remaining front runners to arrive at the eighth pole comfortably in the clear, drew off, kept to some urging until almost the end. BALLYBRIT three wide along the elbow chute, briefly vied for command before getting eased back, sat reserved until the early stages of the run around the full turn, was given his cue and angled into the three path at the three-eighths pole, beating SELJUK to the spot, swung into the stretch, failed to match the winner's acceleration, but continued on well enough to secure second. TAKE IT EASY BABA took the inside route until the furlong grounds, missed out on the place. SHORTCOMING had to contend with another pair for control in the initial stages, shook free and cut the pace, being rated along from the inside, had the closest pursuers getting asked for run by the quarter pole and was shortly afterwards called upon himself, got overwhelmed by the top one then tired steadily thereafter. SELJUK three wide to four wide on the turn, had no rally. JACK'S R WILD quickly tucked along the rail after the start, was sent off it midway down the backstretch, travelled three wide on the turn and failed to make his presence felt. NATIONAL BUCK raced along the outside, was under encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. INFILTRATOR chased the leader from the two path under encouragement departing the backstretch, gave way.
