TEMECULA CREEK three wide in mid pack, came under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, ranged up into contention swinging three wide in upper stretch as five stacked across the track, dug in to seize command nearing the eighth pole, inched away under a drive to prevail. JACKFROST OFCOURSE broke awkwardly brushing the off side stall at the start, came under coaxing to be forwardly placed tracking from the pocket then settled in hand through the turn, scraped the fence in tight quarters at the head of the lane in an attempt to make a lane not readily available, got jostled bumping with REGAL STRIKE and took an elbow to the head in the process, continued inside mildly handled until able to get through in the late stages then kicked home belatedly for the place. OVEREXTENDED three wide towards the rear, commenced a four wide bid from the seven-sixteenths through the turn, moved into contention swinging four wide at the quarter pole, offered up good energy for the show honors. ALSTON GUNTER just off the inside just off the pace lightly prompting, got set down at the quarter pole among a quintet arriving at that station stacked across the track, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. REGAL STRIKE hustled from the start, established the pace from just off the rail in hand, braced for a host of challenges nearing the quarter pole, got set down at that station set to cut the corner into the stretch, had JACKFROST OFCOURSE force his way inside, jostled with that foe to the three-sixteenths trading bumps, inadvertently making contact while driving his mount, got headed a that juncture nearing the eighth pole, fought on mildly until weakening inside the sixteenth marker. SENSATIONAL SLAM hustled from the start, settled towards the rear along the inside, came under urging midway on the turn and made no impact.
