### Footnotes

DELIGHTFUL QUALITY briskly urging leaving the starting gate, was put to a firm hold after achieving the front, was sent over closer to the inside at the end of the backstretch, vied to maintain command feeling another pair on the turn, commenced the stretch two wide and having been called upon, drifted out steadily as the lead was steadily cut into it, raced on even terms with the second place finisher for much of the last sixteenth pole and gamely held on. SURE ROUTE (GB) was taken over to the inside shortly before reaching the half mile pole, tracked the front running three, angled sharply to be three wide after spinning into the stretch, got asked for her best and gave it, drew abreast of the top one past the eighth pole, fought with vigor but was denied. GEISHA GAL contested the pace being three wide for a good portion of the run around the bend, doing so under a firm hold by the pilot, remained a prominent factor until deep into the furlong grounds before backing away. FLASH FORWARD off a beat slowly, swung three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. SENTIMENTAL LASS struck the stall gate's doors just as the field was sent off and running, contested the pace from between opponents for much of the way on the turn, and tired.
