Footnotes

OVERWHELMING forwardly placed four wide early on albeit in reserve from afar off the spurting leader, came under urging at the five-sixteenths now within aim of the front, spun four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the final furlong, fought head to head with GRIDIRON GREAT repulsing that foe to the wire to prevail gamely. GRIDIRON GREAT bumped at the start when RAPID BURN broke inwards, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide for home, rallied with good energy into contention a furlong out, battled head to head with the aforementioned rival but was held to the place despite a good effort. ELLA'S KITTEN two to three wide towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, rallied along the inside into prominence a furlong out, couldn't reel in the top pair while clear of the rest for the show honors. RUNS LIKE A KITTEN towards the rear four wide, got ridden along from the three-eighths, angled eight wide at the head of the stretch, offered up mild late foot for the last major share while never threatening the top. RAPID BURN broke in at the start bumping GRIDIRON GREAT, settled three wide in mid pack, got asked at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild bid to the furlong grounds before weakening late on. HORSE LATITUDES forwardly placed just off the inside in hand, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, angled three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CAPTAIN EASY on the pace inside in hand, spurred away near the five-eighths pole to a clear advantage, had the field take closer order nearing three furlongs out and came under urging in response, held a narrow advantage spinning just off the inside into the lane, was overwhelmed straightened away and folded. STREETS OF FIRE four to five deep in mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled six to seven wide for home and tired. TWO MORE JACS initially on the front, tracked three wide close early, remained patient while the leader spurred away midway down the backside, took closer order with the field into the far turn to be within range three furlongs out, got asked at the five-sixteenths, faded and tired in the lane. THE CULCHIE broke in at the start, saved ground throughout and trailed.
