Footnotes

EXCLUSIVE STRIKE well reserved along the outside down the backstretch, had the pilot glance behind before proceeding to angle outward a short distance past the half mile pole, was in the four path, as a middle member of a line composed of five spread from the rail outward vying for command simultaneously at the five-sixteenths marker, swung from the previously-noted positioning under urging into the stretch, shook free during the ensuing furlong then went on to extend the winning margin, kept busy. MONEY IN MOTION tracked the front runners from the pocket, under a firm hold, was the innermost of a multiple of horses moving at the same time to contend for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was still part of that line of five battling for command spinning into the stretch, failed to keep pace with the winner, but held on well for the place. TOM KITTEN unhurried during the initial stages, picked up the pace at about the winner did, that is upon departing the backstretch, was the outermost one to challenge in earnest for control as the third fraction was being recorded, flattened out late and had to settle for the show. CANTONIC cleared the field making his way along the first turn to gain the advantage, settled into the two path, was between rivals feeling extreme pressure leaving the midway point on the far turn, got called upon soon afterwards, backed away after turning for home. TAWAARED disputed the pace three wide, was in the same path but from between foes at the five-sixteenths pole, tired after reaching the quarter pole. THE BEST GLACIER got away sluggishly after swerving inward sharply at the break, saved ground to the quarter pole while trailing throughout.
