SUNDAY BREAK (JPN) raced close up while between rivals and well in hand, advanced three wide approaching the stretch, went to the front when shaken up in upper stretch, drew clear leaving the eighth pole then held PUZZLEMENT safe while being shown the whip from the right side, driving. PUZZLEMENT was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, swung wide into the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely outside. DEPUTY DASH showed good speed from the outside while in hand, moved up outside nearing the stretch, gained a short lead between calls in upper stretch then stayed on stubbornly to the finish. ESSAYONS showed in front soon after the start, set the pace for three quarters and tired in the stretch. IBN AL HAITHAM (GB) raced within striking distance while three wide and had no response when asked for run. HEIR D' TWINE was outrun early, raced four wide and had no rally. FAST DECISION showed speed on the inside while in hand, chased the pacesetters around the turn and tired in the stretch.
