WIND IN THE FOREST was bumped at the start, was hustled along early, rallied three wide into the stretch, dug in outside and prevailed after a prolonged drive. BALLYMIST contested the pace along the inside and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. FOR WHAT ITS WORTH was outrun early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished well outside. PRETTY SARAH raced close up along the inside, chased the pace and lacked a rally. S. S. BELLE was bumped at the start, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. LEAP TO FAME raced between rivals and had no response when roused. MIGHTY GOOD raced wide throughout and tired. SAND GIRL contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch.
