TOP LASS settled just off the early pace, move through along the rail to gain the lead at the three-eighths pole, drifted out after opening a clear advantage in upper stretch then continued to drift out under right hand urging while holding off the runner-up in the closing strides. SAND AND SONG was outrun early, rapidly closed the gap four wide on the turn, was carried out at the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track but could not get up. DONNA'S SANDEE was well placed between horses, rallied along the inside to threaten in midstretch and held well for a share. LADY WYNNE pressed the pace three wide, drifted five wide to launch her bid at the quarter pole, lodged a mild threat in midstretch and weakened. BOBS PINUP GIRL broke through the gate prior to the start and failed no threaten while saving ground. CAROLINE'S GLORY raced in traffic between horses to the turn and tired. OCALA JORGE failed to mount a serious rally while three wide. ANOTHER RINGER was outrun after breaking slowly. APPROVED BY MOM was hustle up along the rail to gain the early lead and gave way on the turn.
