DR. W sprinted clear on the rail, extended his lead in midstretch, dug in when threatened in deep stretch and prevailed under steady urging. THE LAST WAVE bobbed at the start, raced up close along the rail for a half, angled out in upper stretch and closed steadily while drifting out but could not get up. BRAVE TIN SOLDIER checked at the start, was outrun for a half, swung four wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. JACK ON THE ROCKS pressed in the two path, made a run to threaten at the quarter pole and weakened late. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH was outrun along the rail, swung five wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten. DUBAI DISTINCTION chased three wide for a half and steadily tired thereafter.
