Footnotes

HOIST away alertly, settled tracking initially along the outside, ranged up to press the front at the half mile pole, dueled from that point on while under light urging, was fully engaged by the rider at the quarter pole, raced noses apart through the lane, dug in determinedly to displace the stubborn leader with yards to go and prevail by a hard fought neck. WAR COLONY set the solid fractions while under pressure from the half mile pole, race in tandem with the aforementioned rival through the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths, cut the corner into the lane to extend his margin on the front slightly, dug in stubbornly repulsing the bid by the eventual winner until the final yards, yielded grudgingly at that point while well clear for place honors. KIPPERS N' EGGS tracked the pace from down along the rail, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, displayed a mild kick through the lane for the show honors, drifted out in the late stages just nearing the wire while tiring late on. ASSURED VICTORY unhurried at the rear from the two path, came under a long drive from the three-eighths pole, swung four wide at the quarter pole and offered little. TAZERED crossed to the outside shortly after the start, raced four to five wide throughout while chasing, offered no kick at the head of the lane, was put to a protective hold and not persevered with thereafter. MR. AST settled in midpack early on just off the inside, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the top of the lane and tired.
