Footnotes

TOWN FLIRT broke outward a step and was grabbed hold, ranged up into midpack, raced from along the outside, put to a drive from the half mile pole, took the three path into the lane, continued the pursuit relentlessly, cutting the leader's margin readily during the ensuing furlong, collared the wayward runner up and edged away. BID A MOON broke on top, dropped back to take up the role of stalker soon afterwards, had the rider atop with a snug grip on the reins until the quarter pole, moved up and powered by the hapless early pacesetter when ready to do so, this occurring in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, chose the two path for the run around the bend and kicked off to a comfortable advantage, got released from the previously described hold by the pilot in upper stretch, saw the margin cut into despite having been asked for some run for the initial time through it all, drifted outward noticeably leaving the eighth pole, got reeled in and had to settle for being second best. DECENNIAL set the early splits from the inside, succumbed with little resistance on display when challenged by the second place finisher nearing the end of the backstretch, went on to best the rest. SPEEDY'S GAL saved ground down the backstretch, was in the two path for most of the way around the turn, drifted four wide into upper stretch with no offering to render. FOREVER VOW given a strong warm-up prior to the start, was through after going three-quarters. LEMONS TO LEMONADE three wide, was urged on the turn and folded.
