**Footnotes**

LONGFOR THE CITY departed the backstretch three wide, bided time for most of the way around the turn, got tipped into the four path in preparation for the stretch run, turned for home and took off in earnest after the front runners, struck the front nearing the eighth pole, drew off, was under a brisk hand ride crossing the wire. GREELEY PACK vied for command from the two path on the turn, got displaced by the winner a short distance from the furlong marker, continued onward willingly to secure second. SUNNYSIDER took the inside route, was momentarily in tight midway on the turn and was steadied, got asked for some run a sixteenth later, mustered up a mild response for the show. HERE COMES TOMMY rode the rail until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, started to angle outward from that station until four wide by upper stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. ASSET INFLATION bumped a couple of jumps after the break, disputed the pace on even terms with the runner up from the three path, kept up that pursuit to midstretch then backed away. JUST BE off slowly, saved ground until the furlong furlong and was never a menace. POPPY'S WATCHING was bumped shortly after the start, chased the ongoing pace dispute from the two path on the turn, was under a drive well before reaching the end of the bend, folded. ONE RED CAT bumped from between foes just

out of the gate, was primarily two wide on the turn, tired. SOLENGO taken four wide into the stretch, made no headway and was eased.
