LEILANI'S TICKET underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, crept up towards the front runners, poked a head down in front to lead the field into the stretch, went onward for a couple of additional jumps before getting asked for a response, steadily kicked away from the others. DATTT HAPPY was put to some encouragement leaving the starting gate and grabbed the advantage, tucked along the inside well before reaching the end of the backstretch, left the five-sixteenths marker with none latched on, had the lead snatched away by the winner, albeit by a slim margin, before completing the next sixteenth, battled on with willingness then just held on to the place. HARLEY three wide entering the turn, was one path wider getting off, came home with good energy en route to missing out on second. BROTHER BOB in the four path leaving midpoint on the bend, flattened out. ALL JONESY got outthusted for the lead, took the inside route, under some urging making his way on the turn, tipped outward coming into the stretch and continued on a gradual course to the outside running through the furlong grounds, made no headway. TAPE IT off to a sluggish beginning, swung five wide into upper stretch, had no rally. ALMOST ENGLISH coaxed in the two path while prompting the pacesetter, gave way.
