TERMINUS departed the backstretch three wide, narrowed in on the front runners making his way around the bend, arrived at the quarter pole and challenged in earnest, gained ground readily during the ensuing furlong, continued onward and was soon abreast of the second place finisher, took over for good after going a few more jumps and edged away, doing so being hand urged in the late stages. HANDSOME HARBOR quickly established control, sat entrenched in the two path, cutting the pace being rated on a loosely-contested lead, felt the pressure starting to build up as the third split was being set and got called upon for some run, held his ground with resilience from the head of the stretch to the eighth pole, saw the margin cut into more steadily by the winner thereafter, surrendered to that one past the sixteenth marker, held on well to secure second. I LOVE IT well out in the middle of the track, loped along proceeding down the backstretch, was swung closer towards the rail coming to the half mile pole until about three wide, entered the stretch and mustered up a solid response to rally for the show. STAR OF SARAVA out slightly at the start, was pulled off the nearest opponent before any contact could be made, tracked the runner up taking the inside route until late on the turn, angled out for the stretch run, came up empty. OUR ENTOURAGE was guided over to the inside route prior to the half mile pole, cut the corner into the stretch, had no impact. CHAIRMAN NOW loosely drafted behind the runner up on the turn, was under a full drive by the midway point, folded. STRAIGHT FAX raced along the outside, gave no response when asked to at the three-eighths pole, drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring.
