PRIVATE LAP contested the pace along the inside and tired. BLOWING ROCK was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and tired in the stretch. MUTAWAGED raced wide and tired. LA LA'S PASSION raced wide throughout and tired. YOUR JULES contested the pace while between rivals and tired.
