COLONIAL KID well positioned along the inside, slipped off the rail midway on the turn, moved willingly towards the leaders, responded positively when asked for a response, gained a slim lead by midstretch, then dug in gamely to hold off LES ANTIQUES's late charge. LES ANTIQUES steadied along the rail early, continued to save ground, angled out past the furlong marker, causing CERTIFIABLY ROYAL and ROYAL LORD to both swerve, then finding his best stride, closed strongly in the final yards. CERTIFIABLY ROYAL stalked the early pacesetter, took command past the half, remained prominent until deep stretch, then was bothered and forced to swerve out a bit when LES ANTIQUES angled out late. MARL outrun early, was taken to the far outside at the top of the stretch and came home with good energy. BARONIAL a forward factor while wide, weakened. TONCHE was never a threat. MISCHIEF was no factor off an inside trip. ROYAL LORD raced three wide, entered contention by midstretch, then was flattening out when forced out past the furlong marker. BIRTHDAY BALLOONZ on the front for a half, stopped.
