FULL OF GUT broke on top, had the rider cast a quick peek towards his left, was placed under a snug hold and taken back off the developing pace battle between GOODDAY and PRIMAL BABY, sat perched, with the rider still applying a snug hold on the reins until the seven-sixteenths pole, moved up at that station to join the disputed pace, vied, the widest of a threesome for an additional furlong, before going horse to horse with GOODDAY, turned for home on nearly even terms with that rival, was set down after settling into upper stretch, grabbed the lead during the ensuing furlong, despite drifting out, then continued to bear out all the while increasing the advantage, stubbornly resisting the right handed whip being used by the jockey to counteract it. SAY TOBA SANDY unhurried during the opening stages, was placed four wide midway on the turn, and came home willingly to secure the place. PRIMAL BABY vied between rivals from the nine-sixteenths pole to the seven-sixteenths pole and lacked the necessary stretch response. GOODDAY forwardly placed along the inside soon after the start, argued for the lead with two others throughout much of the running around the bend, remained a prominent factor until midstretch and gave way. ALL DRAMA reserved along the outside under a firm hold for nearly a half, was never a threat. SISTER'S SPEED was never in contention. MRS RABBITS tired off a ground-saving journey, with the rider losing the whip in the vicinity of the eighth pole.
