POLITICAL JUSTICE lightly urged to the front, set the pace under a light hold after clearing to the lead, raced from the two path through the turn until shifted closer to the rail midway, was let out still holding strong to his advantage coming to the three-sixteenths, edged clear through the lane being kept busy to the end. FULTON STREET hustled at the start to be forwardly placed, was pushed along inside from the three-eighths pole, shifted to the two path at the head of the lane, couldn't match strides with his barn mate through the lane while repulsing a bid for the place at the eighth pole finishing willingly for the place honors. THE ZIPSTER three wide in close pursuit, was set down continuing three wide at the quarter pole, ran on bidding for the place honors with a furlong to go, got repulsed weakening late on while safely garnering the show. SKINNY PETER sat well placed in the two path in midpack, came under urging at the three-eighths, proved unable to close in on the front bidding mildly to just procure the last major share. ANTENNA chased the pace four wide through the turn, came under a prolonged drive just past the seven-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick through the lane. SASTRE chased the front four wide through the turn from afar, swung five wide at the quarter pole and never threatened. TOKEN SACRIFICE towards the rear in the two path, swung three wide in upper stretch and made no impact.
