SPINIT TO WINIT tucked into the two path coming to the end of the backstretch, sat within range as the field raced around turn, angled out and was given her cue entering the stretch, raced in tandem with the runner up closing in on the former loose leader, went by that one together with HOT STONES, dueled with the second place finisher to the end and came out on top. HOT STONES chased the pacesetter from the two path, cut into the leader's margin readily during the run through the furlong grounds, arrived at the eighth pole wedged in between foes, got hooked up a duel with the winner shortly afterwards and got denied. ROSIE'S SONG shook free of the competition early down the backstretch, showed the way from the inside, under some urging while doing so on the turn, showed signs of vulnerability by the three-sixteenths pole, yielded about a sixteenth later and steadily weakened into the show slot. CARLA SWEETREVENGE placed four wide at the head of the stretch, made no serious moves. MAXANA underwent a ground-saving journey, came up empty. BRANDINI saved ground until the quarter pole. LET ME BE NUTS off the inside, trailed throughout.
