HOPPY DO off a half beat slowly, rushed up along the inside under hand encouragement to attain a forward position, remained under active handling entering the turn, got set down to a drive halfway around it, angled into the four path coming to five-sixteenths pole, closed in on the duelers and turned for home latched on to them, forged by each one during the next furlong to grab away the lead, then doubled the advantage, driving. FAIRY SNOW was hustled away from the starting gate, got hooked up in a prolonged duel with BROADWAY HAT, sparred with that one from the two path, lightly coaxed to maintain interest, arrived at the quarter pole head to head with the previously-mentioned but with the winner looming boldly from the three path at that juncture, yielded to the top one shortly afterwards, but continued onward gamely to secure second. GO TO THE NET sent over to the inside at the nine-sixteenths pole, was back on the move to the outside midway on the turn, mustered up a mild response to take the show. VICE SQUAD sent on to the inside route in the vicinity of the half mile pole, failed to menace off the subsequent ground-saving journey. BROADWAY HAT had a duel with the runner up commence only a few strides out of the gate, raced as a team with that opponent from the three path and under a firm hold for nearly a half, was between rivals spinning into the lane, got called upon and steadily fell back. POINT AND GO three wide at the three-eighths pole, folded. HARRY CONSOLIDATOR raced along the outside and trailed.
