Footnotes

SEVEN DREAMS contently stalked the pacesetter from the two path making her way down the backstretch, crept up to increase her presence upon entering the turn, closed in readily late, got set down challenging for command from between opponents turning for home, shook free during the ensuing furlong, remained comfortably in the clear, occasionally flashed the whip from the right side in the final sixteenth. CITY GONE WILD rode the rail down the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace leaving the half mile pole, angled outward into the three path at the midway point on the turn, ranged up and challenged for command as the widest of three front runners, failed to keep up with the winner making her way through the furlong grounds, continued onward in a willing manner though to be well clear of the others for place honors. BELLE OF THE WEST chased the ongoing pace dispute from off the inside, entered the stretch from the three path already having been put to a drive, tipped a bit wider still shortly afterwards, proved no match. BOLDCHILDSREVENGE broke slightly to the outside, but was pulled away from the nearest opponent at the time before any serious contact could be made, secured the front and was gradually placed along the rail, came under heavy pressure late on the turn and was asked for some run prior to the quarter pole, succumbed readily and tired. APPEALETTA bobbled at the break, departed the backstretch from the four path, folded. ROCKY FIELD saved ground to no avail. MONGOS EXPRESSION three wide and between rivals at the end of the backstretch, displayed only brief foot.
