UNBROKEN DREAM prompted the pace from just off the inside, took closer order between foes as MALIBU MUDSLIDE joined the pair at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, rallied to seize command nearing the furlong grounds, tussled briefly until inching away in the late stages to prevail. CONZIG tracked the pace along the inside, got set down swinging three wide in upper stretch, offered up late foot to just get up on the wire for the place honors. MALIBU MUDSLIDE three wide within aim in pursuit, took closer order the outermost of a trio at the seven-sixteenths, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, took a narrow command at the head of the lane, got headed nearing the eighth pole, fought on with a mild kick through to the wire but was repulsed then got nipped in the last jump for the place. DIAMOND MAKER saved ground towards the rear ridden along from the five-sixteenths and offered no response. MISS MASTERY away sharply at the start, cut the pace along the inside under pressure from a pair through the turn, got let out at the five-sixteenths, displaced nearing the quarter pole and steadily weakened in the stretch. KIMMIES LUCKY STAR chased just off the inside towards the rear, angled four wide for home under a drive and made no impact. DUST EM MICK hesitated at the start conceding about four lengths to the front, was outrun early on settling just off the inside, came under a ride three furlongs out and trailed throughout.
