GARNET STREET saved ground towards the rear, remained patiently handled to the quarter pole, got set down swinging five wide for home, offered up a good kick rallying to seize command in the final strides and edged away late. PARC MONCEAU three wide in mid pack, got let out at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide at the top of the stretch, took over the front nearing the eighth pole, dug in under a drive but was caught nearing the wire while safe for the place. LADY KIERKEGAARD two to three wide at the rear, got set down at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the show. BELLE GALLANTEY tracked just off the inside from afar, came under urging three furlongs out and offered no serious response. CHARITY BALL five wide early on chasing from close range, shifted to the three path at the seven-sixteenths, continued three wide into the stretch rallying mildly to the eighth pole before flattening out in the late stages. CLASSIC POINT chased four wide early on, shifted into the two path at the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, remained within range to the eighth pole before weakening in the final furlong. READ THE RESEARCH dueled under coaxing from the three path, got set down at the five-sixteenths and put her main rival away nearing the quarter pole while confronted by a host of pursuers, got headed at the three-sixteenths and faltered. SISTER STATE hustled from the gate, dueled from just off the inside urged along, fought head to head through the turn, began to fade nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and folded.
