### Footnotes

SWEPT OVERBOARD raced close up early, found room between rivals along the inside on the turn, moved on through, drew clear, widened when roused in upper stretch and remained well clear while being kept busy to the finish, driving. ALDEBARAN was outrun early, was angled to the inside, rallied on the rail nearing the stretch and finished well inside. CRAFTY C. T. showed speed while five wide, contested the pace and tired after the opening three quarters. AFFIRMED SUCCESS contested the pace while between rivals three wide and tired in the stretch. LEFT BANK showed speed while four wide, contested the pace and tired after six furlongs. GREY MEMO dropped far back in the early going, made up ground along the inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. BURNING ROMA was outrun early, raced five wide and had no response when roused. VOODOO dropped back early, put in a five wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. D'WILDCAT contested the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile. WAKE AT NOON chased the pace from the outside and was finished leaving the backstretch.
