ECCLESIASTIC was hustled along outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear late under a drive. SALUTE THE COUNT was urged along inside, found a clear path into the stretch and finished gamely on the rail to earn the place. WEIGELIA was hustled to the front, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SOUTHERN MISSILE chased the pace while between rivals and lacked a rally. MUSEEB was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. RETRIBUTION contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. CARNERA was bumped at the start, raced four wide and had no response when roused. BARON VON TAP dropped back early, raced inside and never reached contention. WILL HE SHINE was bumped at the start and was outrun along the inside.
